## LOCAL SUPPORT

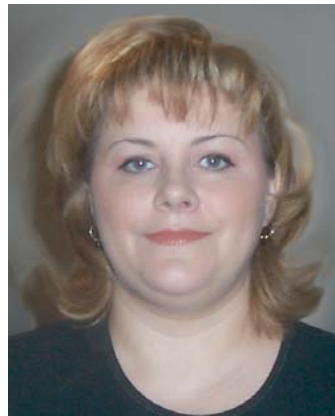
BPspouses Support is NOT a "wives club" or a "social affair".
