*M*y name is Vanessa Crelia, and I am the Founder / Director of BPspouses (Support Program). Our Support Team work together with U.S. Border Patrol Management to help transition of agents, trainees, and families throughout their careers.

We are a separate entity from the Government, the Department of Homeland Security, and U.S. Customs and Border Protection. All our support systems are, in effect, by volunteers and the Government does not financially endorse us at this time. We are relying on advertising and contributions from businesses to help us welcome these new trainees and their families.

When the trainees Enter On Duty (EOD), we hand out information specific to their station, with contact information for support. After they go to the academy, we continue supporting the trainees and their families back home. We spend numerous hours helping each family before they arrive at their destination by answering questions, sending digital pictures of available housing, and simply providing long distance support. All Trainees must complete a five-month long training program at an academy. After they graduate, we assist these trainees and their families in finding housing, physicians, businesses, community information, etc.

SUPPORT

*A*lthough the trainees have graduated the academy, they must continue their training at their local station for another five months before passing their final exams. The strain on new trainees and their families is considerable, and it is our hope that through increased support or donations from communities we can become a greater asset to the Border Patrol, the employees, and their families.

The volunteers that assist the BPspouses, have thus far endured the costs associated with providing these services, which are growing as our service becomes more widely known. Travel expenses, office supplies, postage, maintenance of the web site, internet, server fees, as well as long distance charges are some of the unseen costs associated with providing this service to trainees and their families.

At this time we are seeking for contributions and advertising from businesses to help offset some of these costs. We only have the BEST QUALITY of businesses on our web site.
